U25 / LARC	Sexual Health for U25 - contraception / STI screen LARC – long acting contraception conversation / administration
Mat	Maternity funding, if consult related to pregnancy need documented LMP / EDD
COVID	If patient with COVID requests clinical reivew, or if they are eligible for Paxlovid.
Prim Opt	If offering extended service in community could prevent ED admission commonly DVT (USS), Pneumonia (CXR and follow up), Renal colic (CT KUB), urinary retention (catheter), asthma / COPD (treat and review), Cellulitis (iv and review) create primary options number
Mental health ext consult	One consult available per patient per year – apply via BPAC adult mental health. Patient pays co-payment, but this can be waived if financial and psychological distress
Pall	Patients under hospice care, funding for home visits – can sometimes be used for clinic visits.
Script	Only charge is for script. Please add directions. A quick call to clarify dose etc is still a script charge, a longer call is GMS

Ref / OWC / Form	For referrals, off work cert, that are happening in addition to / instead of consult. Most referrals are included, however if referral is completed at a later date you may advise the patient there will be a charge.
n/c	Lets reception know there is no charge for that interaction. Most pieces of work will attract some charge. Please still add to your screen.
ECG / Cryo / Dressing / Telederm	Please remember to document if referred to PNOD for further work such as ECG / Telederm / Cryotherapy – these attract an additional charge.
